

Combination Welder/Pipefitter

Overview

The Combo Welder/Pipefitter must be trained in a variety of welding processes, including arc welding and oxy-fuel welding. Must possess the ability to set up equipment and weld either pipe, plate or structural steel using arc, gas-shielded arc, or gas welding equipment. Will work from blueprints, sketches, specifications and produce quality work with reasonable efficiency. Will obtain certification as necessary. Must learn and understand all safety hazards related to the work and effectively operate work-related tools and equipment. Will be required to work in a plant operations or construction jobsite setting. Must work in a team environment and help other workers as needed.

Responsibilities

- Prepare materials to be welded and weld components.
- Perform maintenance on welding equipment.
- Perform simple piping installations and repairs.
- Assist other mechanics or craft workers as needed.

Qualifications

- Must be able to push/pull, lift, or carry up to 50 lbs.
- Must be able to communicate to safely perform work.
- May operate hand and power tools (electric, gas, and pneumatic) of all types.
- Climb and maintain balance on scaffolds and stairs.
- May be required to work in confined spaces.
- May be exposed to adverse weather conditions.
- Communicate effectively with management and fellow workers.
- Decision making skills that take into effect safety and quality of job task.
