

Refractory – Bricklayer, Gunite, Nozzleman Positions

Position Overview

The Refractory Bricklayer/Apprentice works with our traveling (150-mile radius – not limited to) refractory construction team to work on customer sites at various locations around the Louisiana/Gulf Coast region. We repair, replace, and install refractory material and refractory systems in the heat process industry. Typical work includes installing fire brick, gunite, modules, castables, carpentry/forms, etc. Also includes demolition, welding/fabrication, mechanical repairs, and fiber insulation. Successful candidates would have a background in bricklaying and construction industry knowledge. Safety equipment (PPE) will be used on various projects and respirators may be required. Applicants should be able to lift 55 lbs. Applicants must also have their own transportation and be able to travel during projects.

Responsibilities

- Previous work history in construction trades (bricklaying, gunite, carpentry, masonry, construction, mechanics, welding, concrete, insulation) desired.
- Safety training (OSHA 10 preferred).
- Experience with heavy equipment (forklifts, extended boom lifts, man lifts, etc.).
- Attention to detail, ability to follow guidelines and procedures.
- Able to accurately read a tape measure (both in metric and standard units).
- Excellent communication skills, both verbally and in writing (including accurate and timely completion of paperwork).
- Ability to learn and retain new skills and knowledge.
- Working as a team to complete tasks in an accurate and timely manner.
- Ability to pass a federal background check required for some locations.

Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED preferred, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Ability to complete basic math functions.
- Ability to communicate (written, verbal).
- Manual dexterity required for operating machinery.
- Ability to be a team player and meet deadlines.
- Ability to work occasionally near mechanical parts and in high places, confined spaces, etc.
- Ability to pass a drug screening.
